ORGANIZATION	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ The students' names are written in the Drive document shared with the teacher. ✓ A presentation of the video is included. ✓ Different types of activities are presented. ✓ Linking words are used (<i>Firstly, and now it's time for the second questions, etc</i>). ✓ A conclusion with expressions like: "<i>Finally, in conclusion</i>", "<i>thanks for your attention</i>" is included. 				
USE OF ENGLISH	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ There are not grammatical mistakes. ✓ A variety of grammatical structures and vocabulary is included. ✓ There are not spelling or punctuation mistakes (capital letters and use of commas and stops). 				
VIDEO	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ The video or videos presented are useful to practice your English and interesting. ✓ The video is in English and it is easy to understand if no subtitles are included. 				
ACTIVITIES	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ Your activities are elaborated, useful, creative, interactive and interesting. ✓ Your discussion questions engage other classmates promoting interaction. ✓ Classmates participate at the same time (pair or team work, singing aloud, completing a worksheet). ✓ You can improvise other questions not prepared in advance to create more discussion.
